GIFT AID

If you pay tax in the UK, Gift Aid is one of the simplest and most beneficial ways of giving to charity. For every pound you give to Future Talent using Gift Aid, we will receive an extra 28 pence from Inland Revenue. So a £10 donation from you turns into a £12.80 for your chosen charity. Imagine the difference that could make to us, whilst not costing you an extra penny!

Gift Aid is very easy to use, and can apply to any donation irrespective of the amount or how you choose to make your donation (cheque, postal order, cash, even donations made in a foreign currency!).

If you are a UK taxpayer, you will qualify for Gift Aid, provided you pay as much tax as the charity will be entitled to reclaim as a result of your donation. So, for example, if you make a donation of £100 to Future Talent in any financial year, you must pay at least £28 tax to Inland Revenue in that same financial year to qualify for Gift Aid.

All you have to do is download and print off a Gift Aid Declaration Form, fill it in and send it to us with your donation.

You only need to fill it in once, no matter how many donations you make to Future Talent, and can cancel the declaration if you wish (for example, if your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Charity reclaims) by notifying the charity.

Furthermore, if you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief, by including all donations you make under Gift Aid in your Self Assessment tax return— as much as £23 for every £100 you donate.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65
